

SCORE POSTING GUIDE

Follow this guide to post scores following any event. Computers are located in every proshop. Be sure to post score following the ESC system.

Team Captain: The designated team captain of each foursome is responsible to ensure all scores for his foursome are posted at the end of play. This includes all tournaments where all players play their own ball i.e., individual and group stableford and best ball formats.

Preferred Lies: All scores must be posted even if the ball was played up.

Tournament Scores: Some MGA events are designated as either *H or *T. *H event scores must be entered into GHIN as HOME. *T scores must be entered as TOURNAMENT HOME.

Adjusted Scores: Posted scores must be adjusted for handicap purposes as per the following:

USGA GHIN System Equitable Stroke Control (ESC)

Course Handicap	0 – 9	10 – 19	20 – 29	30 – 39	40+
Max Score per Hole	Dbl Bogey	7	8	9	10

Click “Club Member Score Posting”

Enter the POA# for each golfer – If their number contains 7 digits you must omit the first number. Example: 1013218 is entered 013218.

Click “Next”

Click on appropriate course and Click “Next”

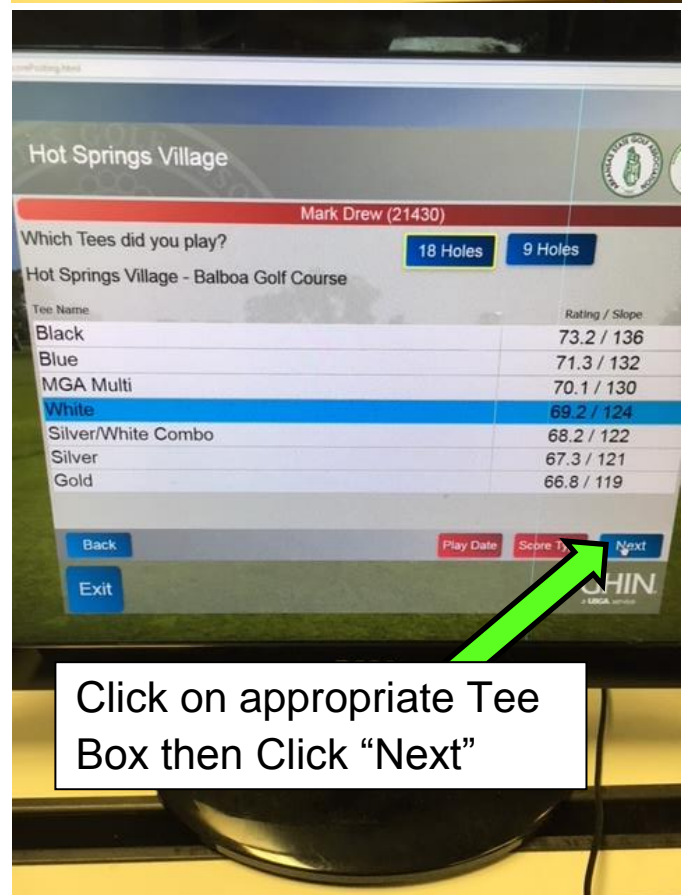
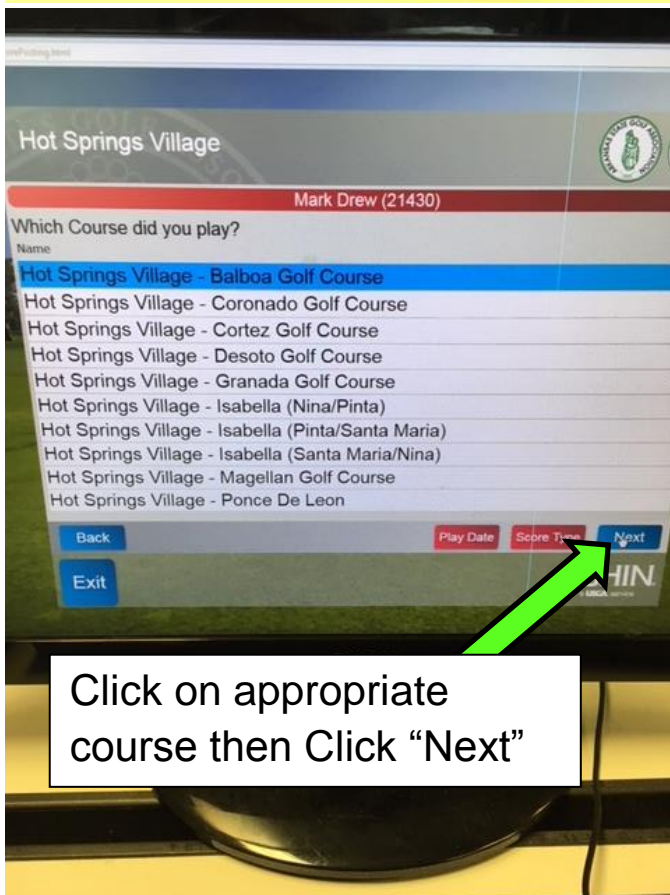
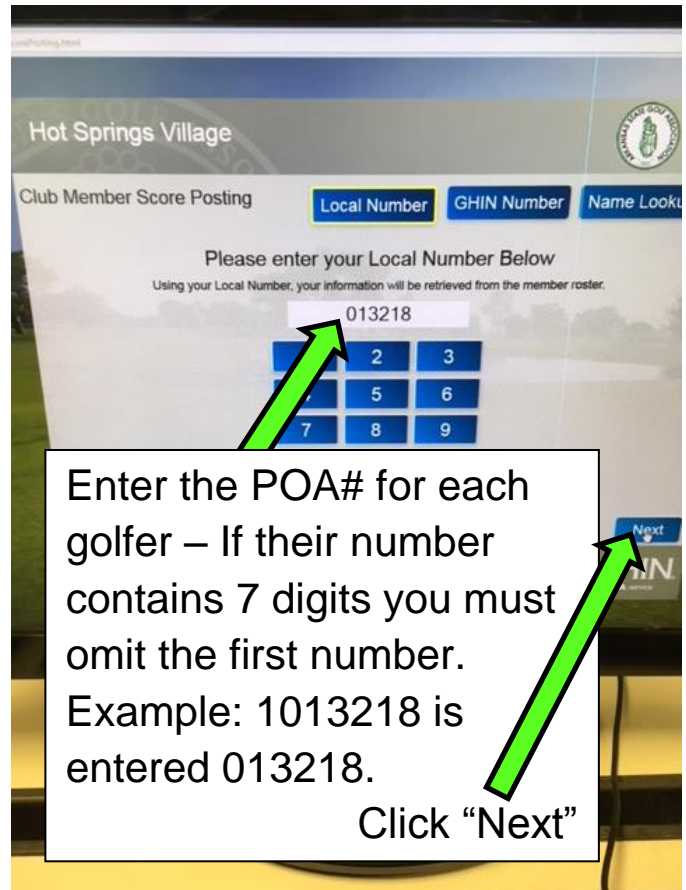
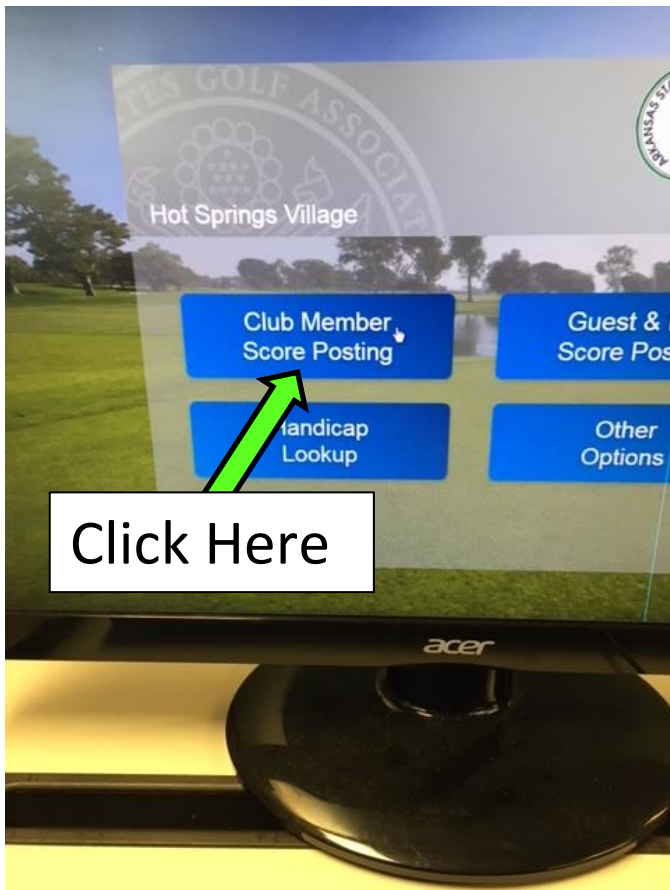
Click on appropriate Tee and Click “Next”

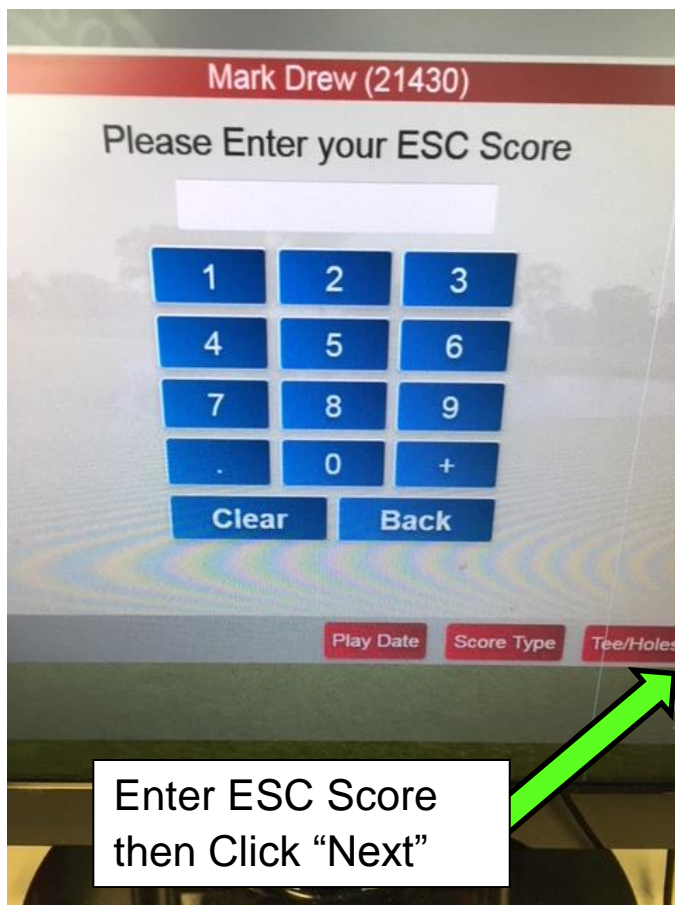
Enter ESC Score and Click “Next”

Verify information is correct. Make sure “Score Type” is correct (Home or Tournament Home). If event is designated as “*T”, score must be entered as “Tournament Home”. Click on “Score Type” then Click “Tournament Home” and then Click “Next”.

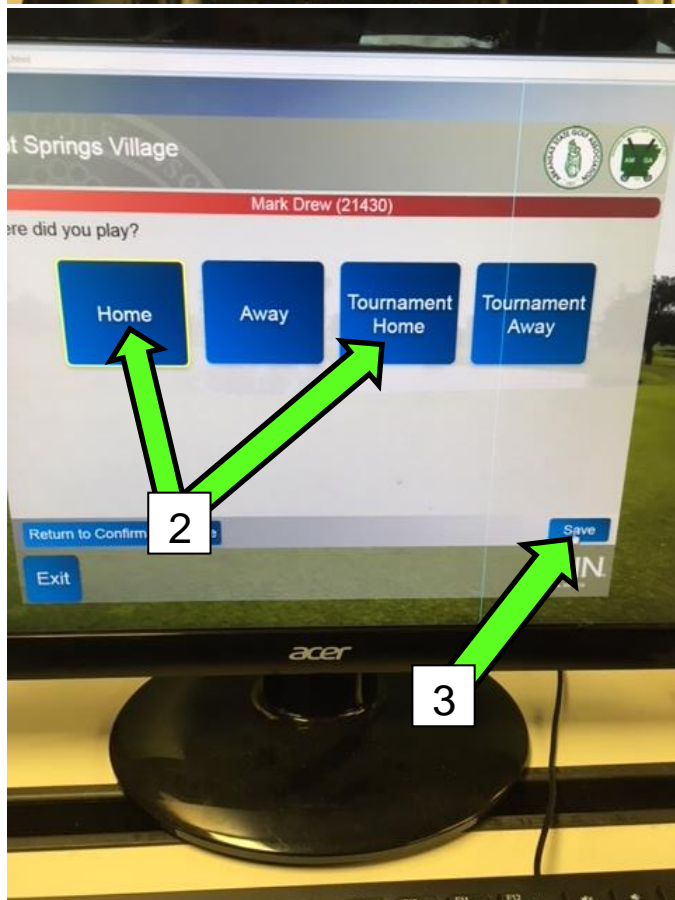
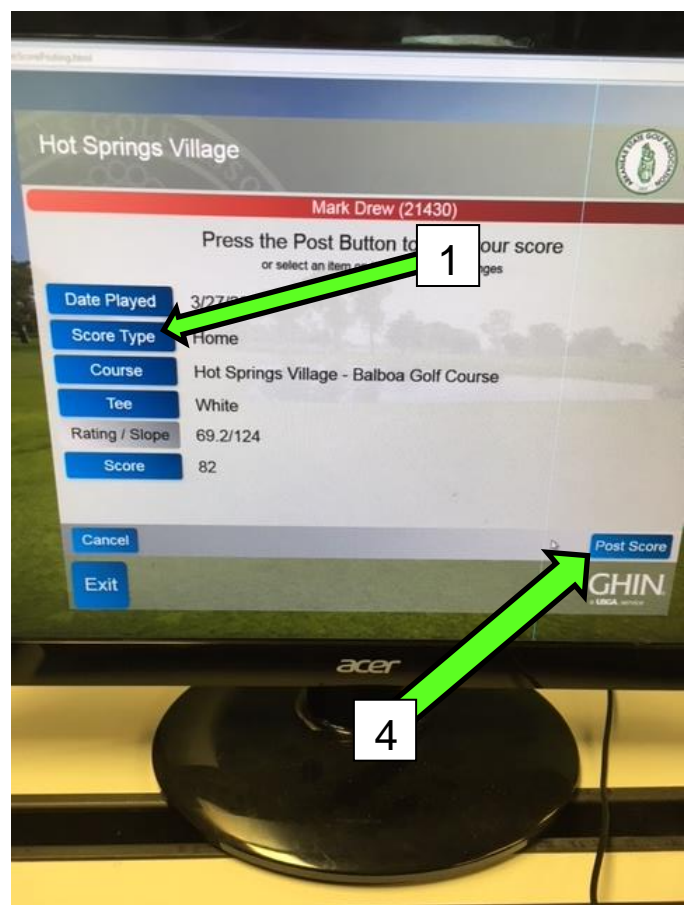
Re-verify information is correct and Click “Post Score”.

Repeat steps for all golfers in your foursome.
