

Handicap Adjustments For Group 2, 3 and 4 If Not Playing (Designated) Group Tees

1. A tee box change is allowed once per year. Notify your Group Supervisor.
2. Group 2 (Silver/White) players may choose to play from the White Tees
3. Group 3 (Silver) players may choose to play from the Silver/White Tees.
4. Group 4 (Silver) players may choose to play from the Gold Tees.
5. Handicaps on all scorecards are calculated from the designated Group Tees by the golf department.
6. Anyone in Groups 2 and 3 playing from the White or Silver/White Tees must add strokes to their handicap and anyone in Group 4 playing from the Gold Tees must subtract strokes from their handicap.
7. In events where net scores are not used, a player may choose to play from the tees designated for that group without jeopardizing the "once a year rule" pertaining to the tee box choice.
8. This is a local MGA rule and the USGA course handicap adjustment will not be used in events except, for Match Play. (see below)
9. For Match Play, when players are using different tees, consult the handicap tables at each Pro Shop or the GHIN course handicap calculator to determine the handicap for each player.
